


Open Data Portals: Structure

EC. Promotion actions

- CIP: European Public Sector Information Platform, to raise awareness and exchange good practices. More planned activities under CIP are foreseen
- LOD2-FP7 project to increase public access to high-value, machine-readable data sets generated by the European, national/regional/local public administrations
- The Linked Open Data Around the Clock (LATC) FP7 Support Action supports interesting partners to publish and consume Linked Data
- Digital Agenda Stakeholders' Day: "Priority #3: Beyond raw data: public sector information, done well". A discussion on what is next to Open Data
- Provide Semantic Interoperability Center Europe (SEMIC) as a possible registry for vocabulary, metadata schemas and EU URI management (semantic assets)

Open Data > Linked Data

From Open ... to Linked Data

- make your stuff available on the web (whatever format)
- make it available as structured data (e.g. excel instead of image scan of a table)
- ♦♦♦ non-proprietary format (e.g. csv instead of excel)
- ♦♦♦♦ use URLs to identify things, so that
 people can point at your
 stuff
- ♦♦♦♦♦ link your data to other people's data to provide context

Open Data (European) Strategy

- Adapting the framework in favour of data re-use, including legal, soft law and policy measures,
- Mobilising financing instruments by prioritising open data in R&D&I and infrastructure programmes,
- Facilitating coordination and experience sharing across the Member States.



PSI Directive revision


- Legal basis underpinning the process (approved in 2003!)
- Planned revision of the PSI Directive in 2012
 - Scope? Cultural, scientific, broadcasting sectors?
 - Non-compulsory re-use regime?
 - Charging principles?
- Recent development → Revision process launched

"Every citizen shall have the right to participate in the democratic life of the Union. Decisions shall be taken as openly and as closely as possible to the citizen." (art. 10)



Not less than one million citizens who are nationals of a significant number of Member States may take the initiative of inviting the European Commission [...] to submit any appropriate proposal on matters where citizens consider that a legal act of the Union is required for the purpose of implementing the Treaties." (art. 11)

Implement regulation 211/2011, the EC has launched the "ECI" and "OCT" Projects




European Transparency Initiative


- Transparency initiative first discussed in the Commission in 2005

 - Mandatory disclosure of information about the beneficiaries of EU funds under shared management
- Preparations for Financial Transparency System started in 2006


