Unleashing the Potential of Cloude Computing in Europe

- Analysing based on several studies
- Defines three key actions

EC estimates that actions could by 2020 mean

- 45 € billion direct spend on Cloud Computing
- 957 € billion cumulative impact on GDP
- 3,8 million jobs

October 2013 Council Conclusion (EUCO 169/13)

The European Commission and the Member States, with the support of the "European Cloud Partnership", should continue to make every effort to put Europe at the forefront of cloud adoption. The European Council calls for the establishment of a strong network of national digital coordinators which could play a strategic role in Cloud.





Fragmentation of the digital single market

- Differing national legal frameworks
- Uncertainties over applicable law and data location
- Trust and security, data protection, consumer protection, criminal law, ...

Problems with contracts

- Worries over data access and portability
- Liability for service failures such loss of data
- Ownership of data
- → Safe & Fair Contract Terms and Conditions
- → Model contract terms, SLAs, code of conduct

Jungle of standards

- → Cloud Standards Coordination, map (ETSI)
- → Security Certification (ENISA)

Groups of action

- → Flexible common framework of best practices
- → Systematic consensus building targeting all stakeholders





Trusted Cloud Europe framework










Figure 6: Need for cost reductions





Figure 5 Visualization of the deployment models of gov Clouds






