Challenge #1

Economy ... up to 70% of overall costs can be saved in case of timely stroke diagnoses and continuous hospital patient onboarding process ...



Challenge #2

Efficiency ... in average 3 hours of shift nurse spend with paperwork and up to 30% of time is spent by unnecessary commute and periodic tasks ...

Challenge #3

Empathy ... between 3 – 20 patient visits a day are required while periodic schedule very unlikely meet patient requirements as every patient needs are highly individual ...

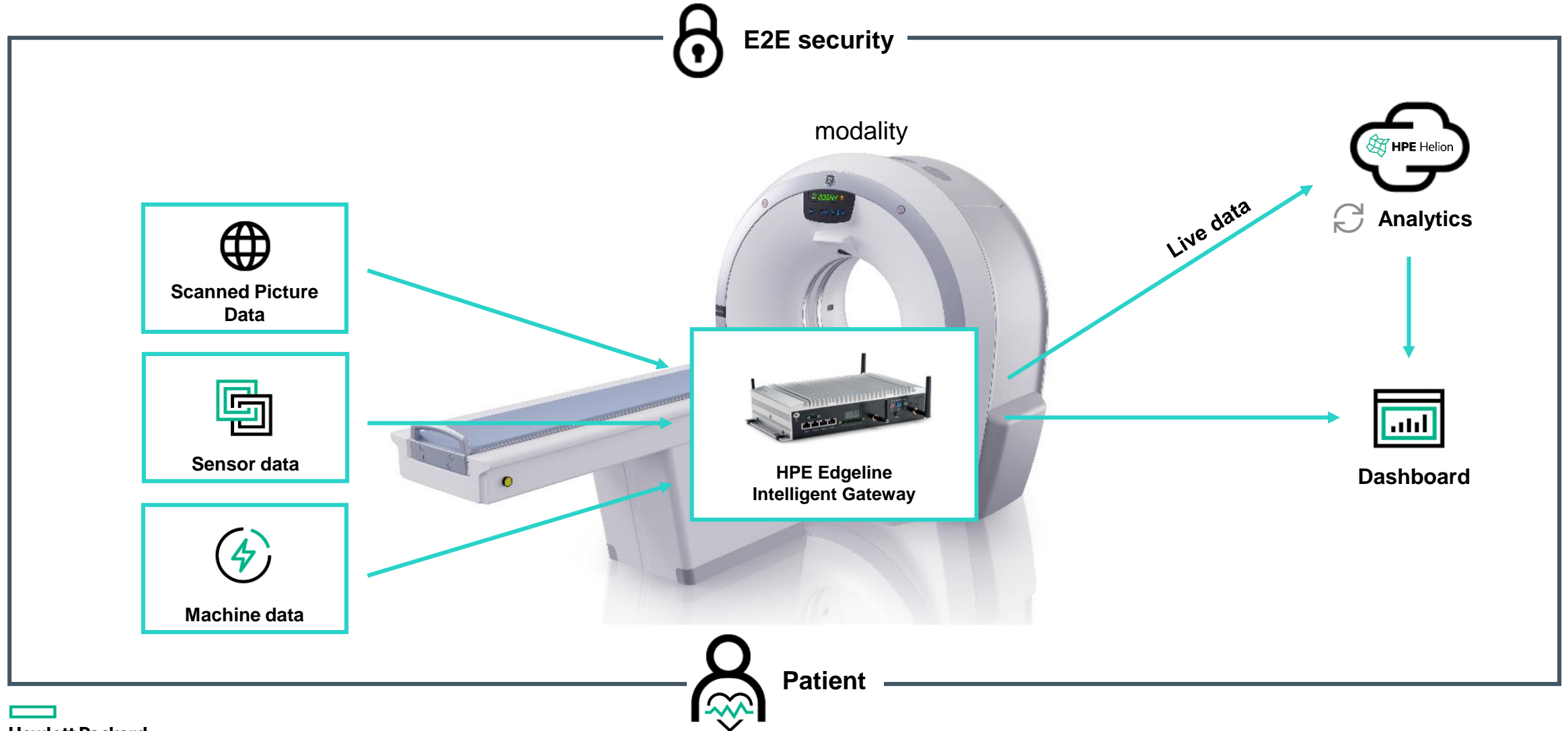
