
The State of the Digital Decade 2023 package








A concrete focus for action:

ICT specialists



Where are we now?

Total number of ICT specialists in 2022 was 9.37 million across EU

Under current conditions, it will be close to **12** million by 2030




What is our goal by 2030?

Target: At least 20 million ICT specialists in the workforce

A concrete focus for action:

SME digital intensity



Where are we now?

In 2022, 69% of SMEs reached a basic level of digital intensity

(an enterprise uses at least 4 of 12 selected digital technologies)



Our goal by 2030

General Objective: high level of digital intensity and innovation

Target: more than 90% of the Union SMEs reach at least a basic level of digital intensity

SDD Recommendations for Slovakia

- Slovakia should accelerate efforts in the digital skills area.
- Particular attention should be given to closing the digital gap, and to ensuring the inclusion of vulnerable groups in all digital trainings, to maintaining a positive trend for the number of ICT graduates as well as to the attraction and retention of ICT specialists.
 - Slovakia should step up its efforts in the area of digitalisation of businesses.
 - Slovakia should facilitate access to training, information and knowledge sharing and other supportive actions, including through European Digital Innovation Hubs, to make further progress in the digitalisation of businesses.
