initial situation:

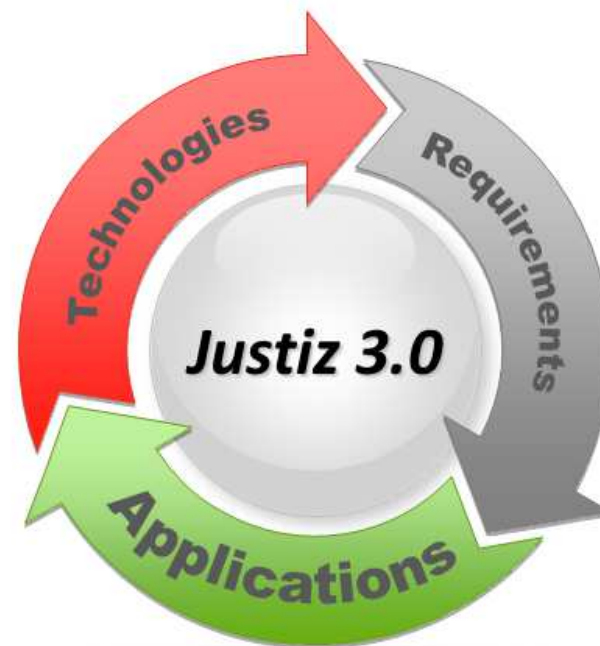
- widespread and successful use of IT for several decades (since 1980)

approach:



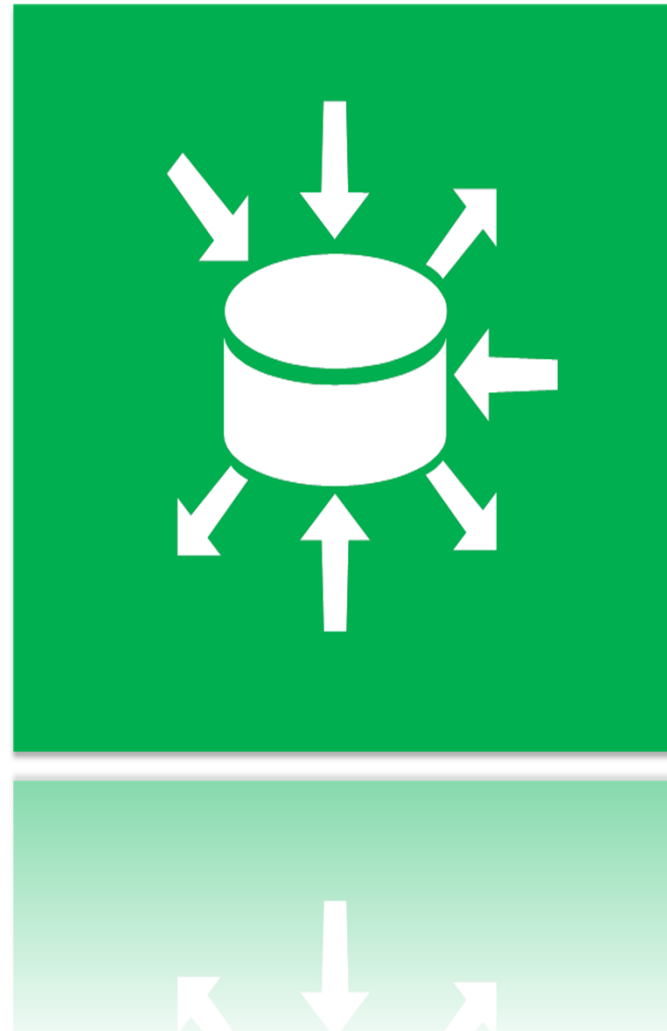


state of play:

- first pilot run of digital file management intended by end of 2015



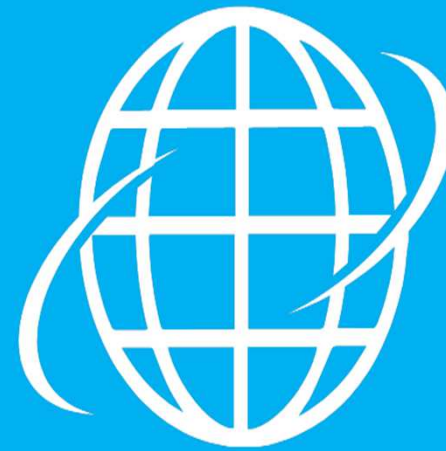

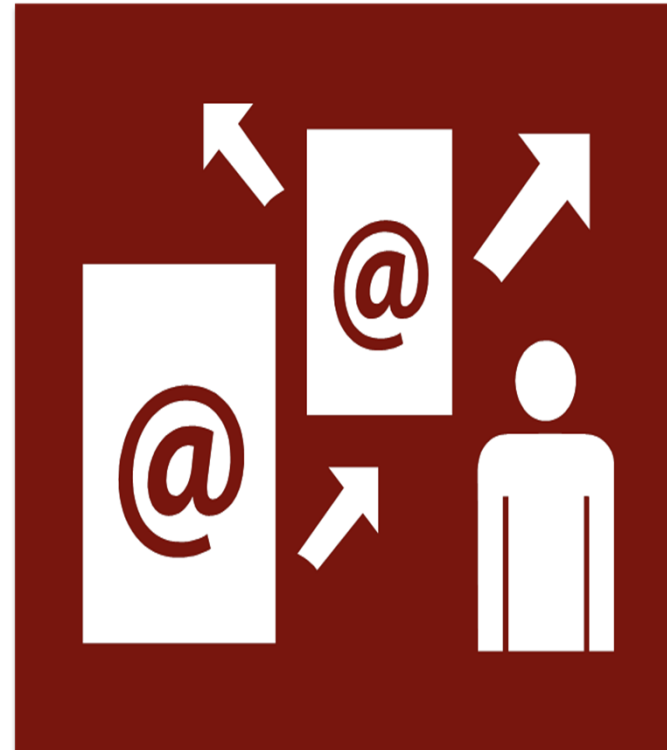


parallel allocation of "jobs" within a file

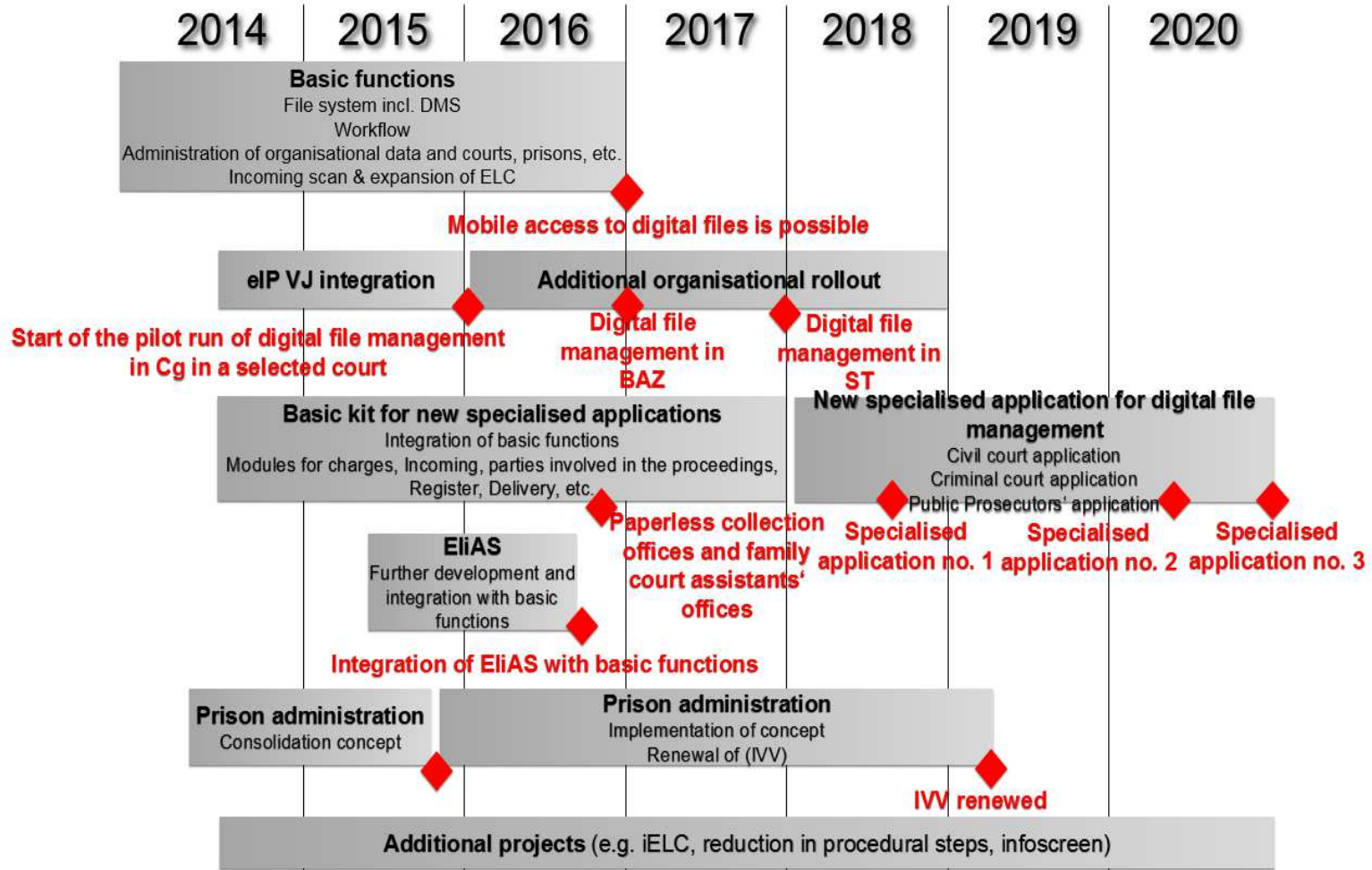


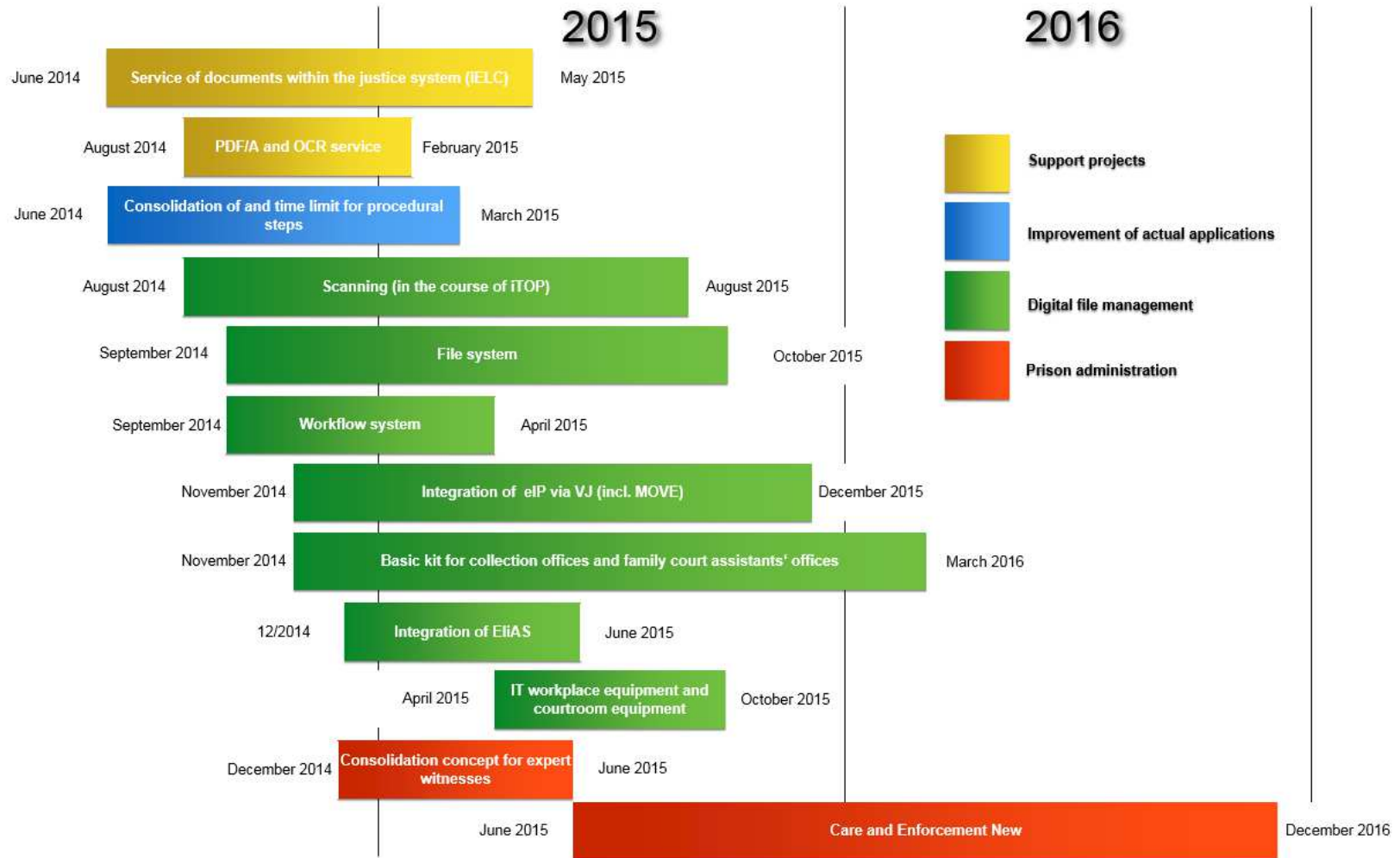


key findings in a nutshell:

:

- entire contents of files must be available in digital form
- several users can access the file at the same time
- users can search, process and sort file contents electronically
- mobile IT workplace will be possible
- delivery of outgoing documents centrally and electronically
- flexible allocation of tasks within one file
