- Establishment of new policy rules, coordination and control system



A single Agency responsible for e-government





Operational since 1 December 2016.

CHAIRPERSON, appointed by the Prime Minister for a period of 5 YEARS

SEGA is a **New** body but also a **successor**

REGULATORY ACTS

 draws up and proposes draft regulatory acts in the field of eGov

STRATEGY

- draws up and proposes
 Strategy for eGov in Bulgaria;
- approves sector strategies and monitors the implementation plans;

CONTROL & COORDINATION

- between administrative authorities regarding eGov;
- approves
 project
 proposals,
 coordinate and
 control projects
 for eGov

DEVELOP & MAINTAIN

- eGov shared resources;
- single portal for access to electronic administrative services



Focus of the e-government policy

- New strategic framework
- Integration of systems and interoperability
- Implementation of the e-government principles
- Re-use of solutions
- Gradual shift from individual separate solutions to using the shared e-government resources
- Open data



By 2023 each citizen of the Republic of Bulgaria shall be able to communicate entirely digitally with the state administration, receiving easy-to-access end-to-end secure personalized administrative services

- 65 base registers connected by 25 central administrations
- Over 13 700 000 transactions for 1 year
