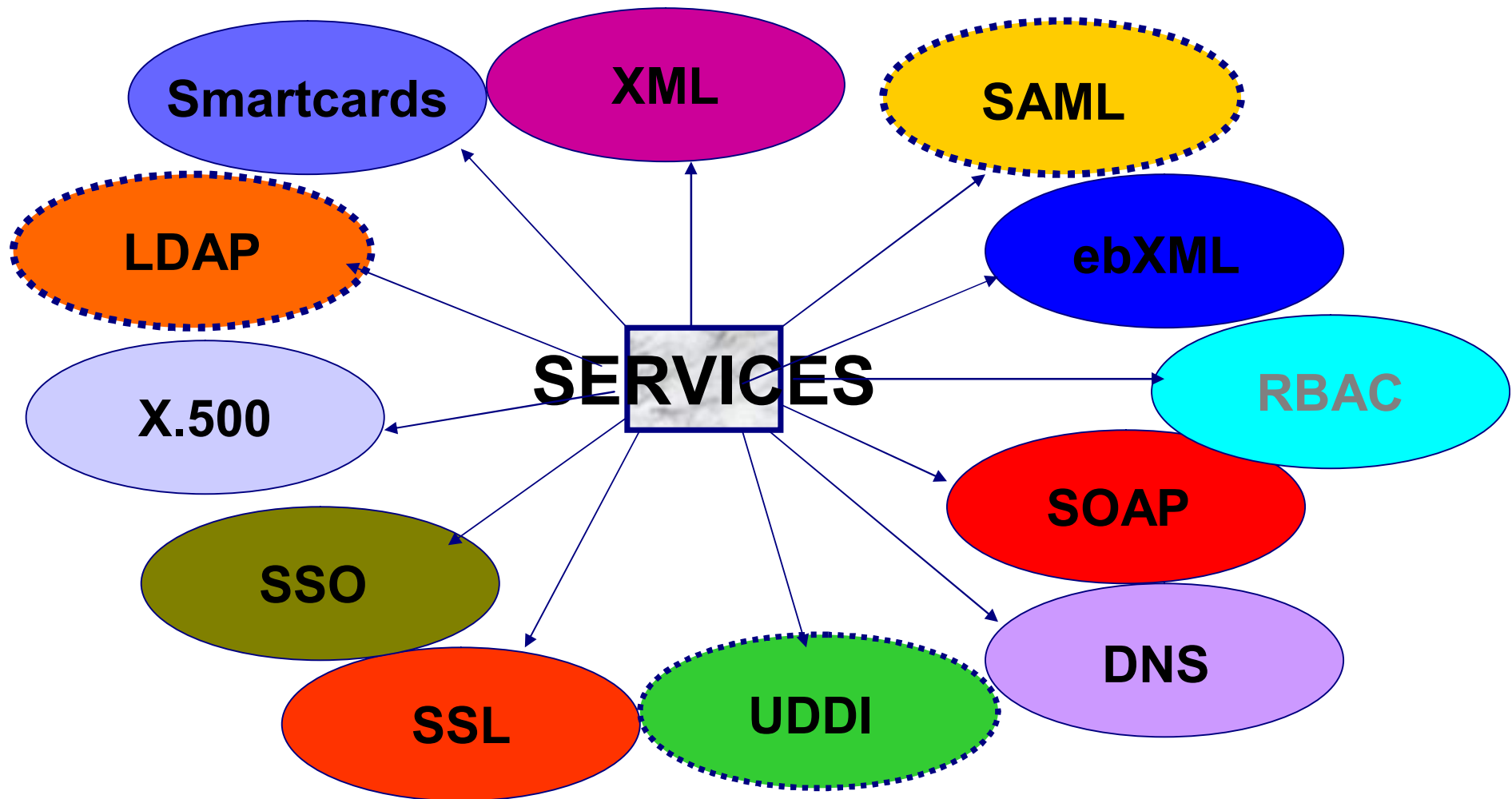
# Why is Directory management essential to E-Government?
