Healthcare in England



Every year, the NHS delivers:

- 17 million inpatient admissions through 200 Trusts
- 270 million GP appointments through 7000 practices
- 1.1 billion prescriptions through 11,500 pharmacies

The carbon footprint of the NHS is 25 megatonnes of CO2 equivalents, of which patient and visitor travel makes up ~10%

In 2016, the average patient travelled 77.6 miles in a car for medical appointments

Changing regulatory environment



- Delivering a 'Net Zero' National Health Service Report and Statutory Guidance
- The Health and Care Act 2022- new duties on NHS England to meet climate goals
- Rapid diagnostic centres (RDCs): faster diagnosis and increasing efficiency + reducing carbon emissions
- NHS@Home and community diagnostic hubs






AMR



By 2050, if nothing is done, 6 million people will die of an antibiotic resistant infection

65% of GP visits are for respiratory tract symptoms

35 million prescriptions for antibiotics annually

12,000 people died an unnecessary antibiotic resistant death in 2021 in the UK: more than breast cancer

Self tests with clinical confidence



CRP testing is already part of NICE guidance and NHS pathways

Not used due to costs

At 0-20 mg/L, bacterial infection is unlikely

At 20-100 mg/L, use clinical judgment but recommend watch and wait

At >100 mg/L, prescribe antibiotics

Self tests with clinical confidence



Planned Test Menu:

- CRP test- launch H2 2025
 - antibiotic prescription
 - rheumatology

- Menopause test- launch H1 2026
- PSA test- launch H2 2026

Pathways to users



CRP test:

Prescribing pharmacists seeking to deliver best in class care and customer confidence

Menopause test:

Partner with Apps who deliver advice around symptom tracking but want to extend their offering

Partner with wearables to extend the information they can gather
