
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#### The case for change: healthcare systems are not performing optimally



### Value-based healthcare concept was introduced by Porter & Teisberg in 2006




The introduction of a new strategic approach to change value creation in healthcare



### Central to the success of VBHC is the ability to measure outcomes that matter to patients in a consistent way







#### VBHC Example: Breast Cancer Outcomes – Santeon Hospital Network, NL




By measuring the outcomes that matter most to patients, the Santeon hospital network in the Netherlands has identified improvement initiatives to increase the value of care for breast cancer patients.




