

Accession into EU – the challenge for Slovak Republic



- →it means to fulfill agreed conditions between EU and Slovakia before the Accession date
 - > it means to prepare people to handle :
 - new administrative processes & procedures
 - to understand EU Community Law and its implications
 - to speak foreign languages
 - to be able to compete on EU single market
 - to be "mobile" within EU single market
 - > it means for state to have enough money to co-finance the projects
 - > it means to be able to coupe with constant "Change" on EU market
