
CLOUD E-GOVERNMENT IMPACT

- Advantages of “**Shared Services**” Concept
 - Infrastructure consolidation, application maintenance cost, shared services architecture, SaaS contract consolidation
- Geo-political adoption
 - US : 25 points Reform program of federal information technology management
 - EU : Cloud consultation – Special advisor: Vivek Kundra
 - Canada: ONE consolidated - new IT agency (2 billion, 8000 workers)
 - Australia: Federal government community cloud








