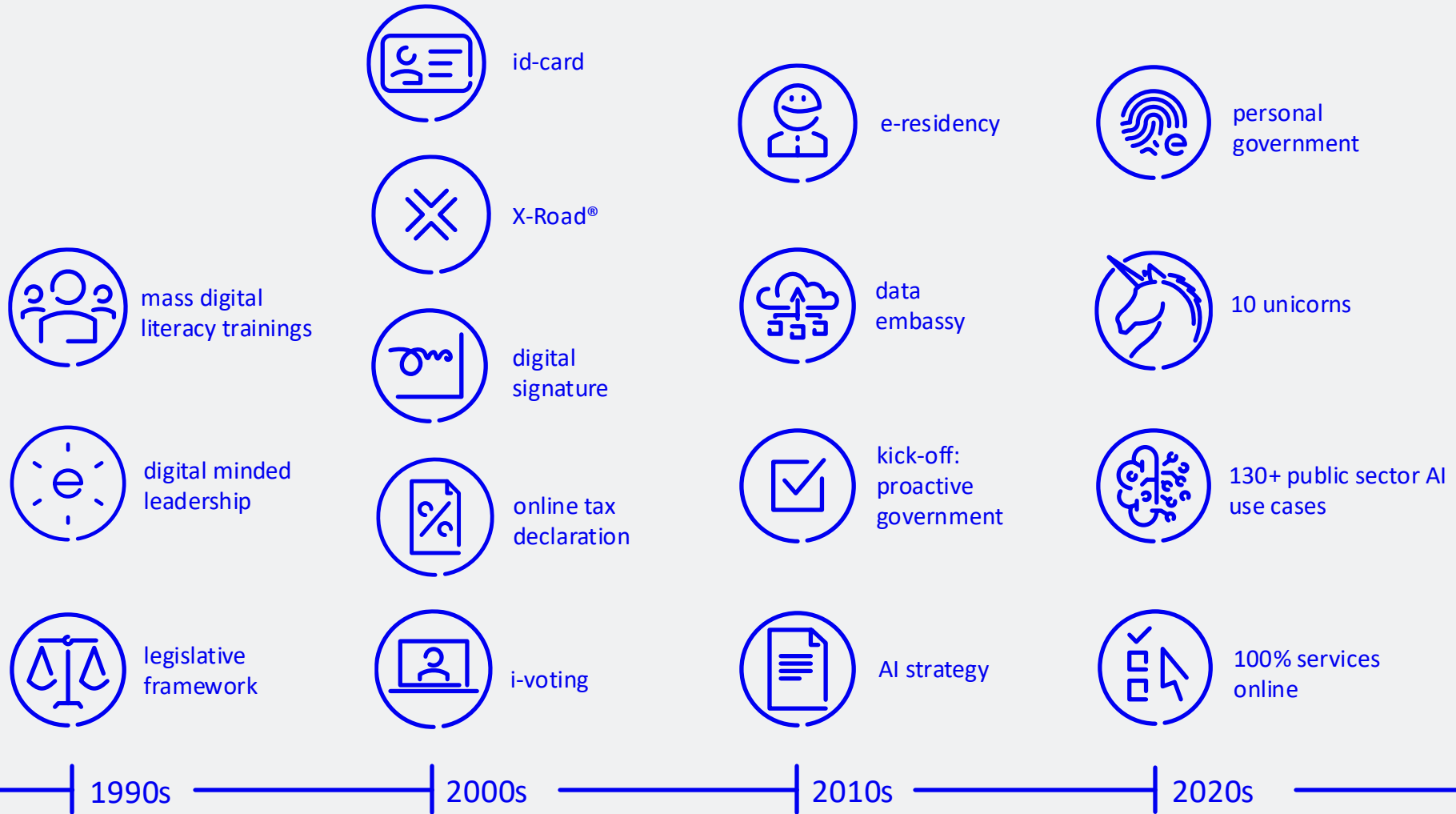
a modest country

the strongest identity since 2002



- + electronic ID is compulsory
- + 64% use ID-card regularly
- + 19% people use mobile-ID
- + 53% use smart-ID

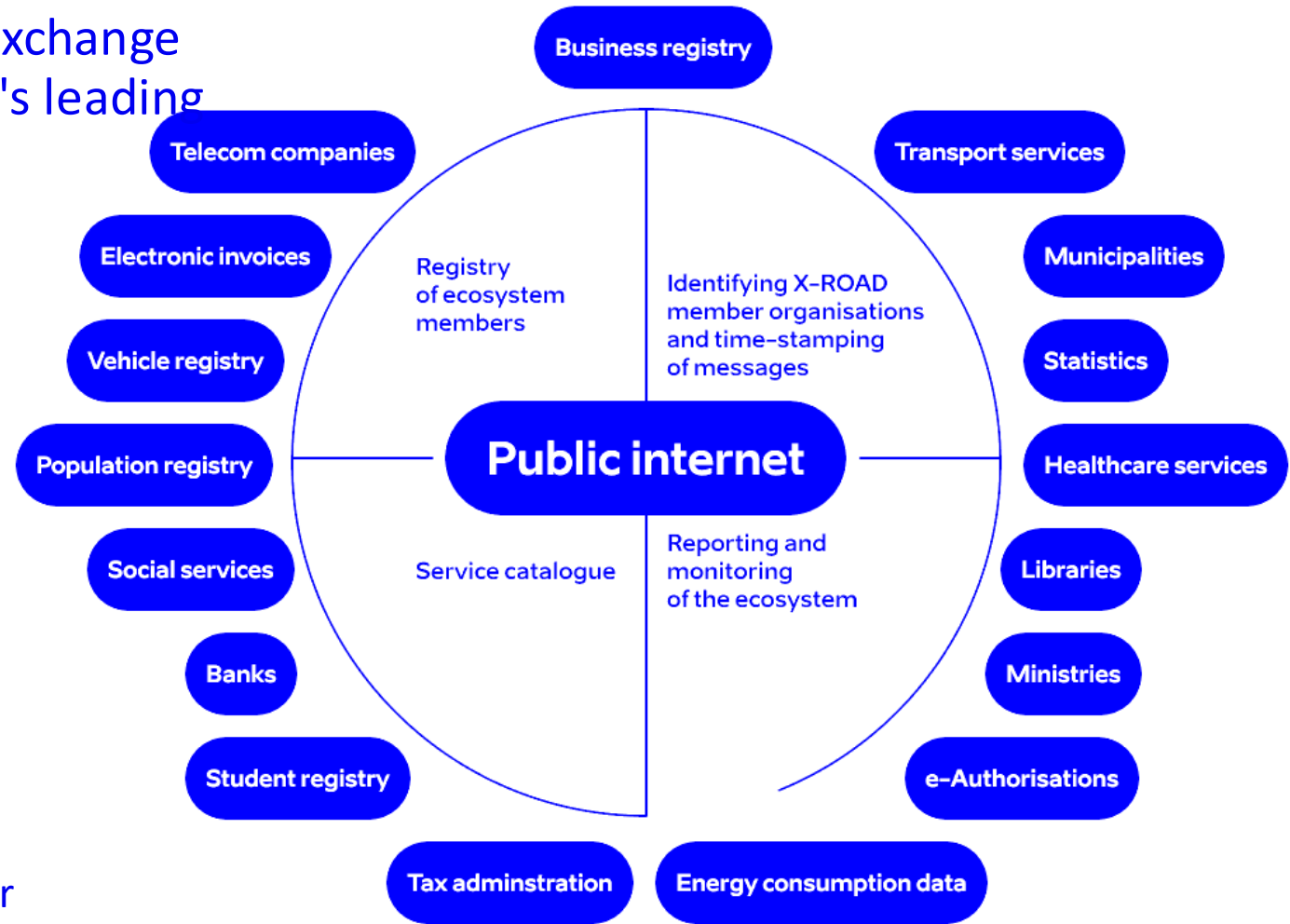
