




## eGovernment system-architecture






## eGovernment Concept

- Resolution of the Council of Ministers on July 9, 2002
- Objective: Increase in inter-departmental data exchange and IT-collaboration
- Key features:
  - eServices
  - Basic IT-components
  - IT-standards
  - Infrastructure





# 1<sup>st</sup> column: eServices






#### **eServices**


- Objective: Increase in customer service for citizens and businesses
- Project steps:
  - November 2002 Januar 2003: Review and analysis of online capacity of more than 1.300 government services
  - July 2003: Prioritization of 32 services for expedited online realization; prioritization criteria such as:
    - Demand for service
    - Complexity of service
    - Number of authorities involved rendering service
  - Currently: Prozess review and optimization
  - Then: Online realization

## **Basic Components**






## **Basic Components**

- Basic IT-component = IT-system for adressing tasks existing throughout all departments
- Objective: Increase in interdepartmental data interoperability
- Project steps:
  - Analysis of system landscape in August 2002
  - Definition of 34 basis components, such as document management systems, facility management systems, human resources administration etc.
  - Definition of head project managers for each basic IT-component for implementing the migration phase, "one-for-all"-principle
  - Coordination of IT-procurement by IT-TaskForce
  - Migration to shared/standardized components



## 3rd column: IT-Standards






### **IT-Standards**

- IT-Standards: Product definition for IT-procurement
- Objective: Increase in interdepartmental data interoperability
- Project steps:
  - Review and analysis of all deployed software and IT-systems within the Bavarian state government
  - Definition of 13 modules for IT-standards, e.g., document exchange, database systems, office software, email client
  - Definition of 3 products for each module (1 open source, 2 proprietary, e.g. Internet browser: Mozilla, Internet Explorer, Netscape)
  - Migration to IT-standard conform products





# Infrastructure – Bavarian Authority Network

- Bavarian Authority Network links 89 state authorities and 873 municipalities
- World biggest centrally managed router network (4.000 routers)
- Objective: Linkage of all Bavarian public authorities into one network
- Expansion of the Authority Network as of March 2003, integrating data, voice and mobile transmission





## Integration of municipalities

- eGovernment Pact between the Free State of Bavaria and the Municipality Associations on July 15, 2002
- Actions:
  - Creation of a joint authority guide with electronic forms
  - Customer-oriented improvement of administrative procedures
  - Promotion of a shared procurement platform
  - Cooperation for development of IT standards
  - Linkage of all municipalities to the Bavarian Authority Network




## **Best Practice eGovernment Applications**

- Virtual Marketplace Bavaria (<a href="www.baynet.de">www.baynet.de</a>) Authority guide with 2,370 services including product sheets and local and topical categories eCommerce: 700,000 Bavarian companies Info and Communities: News, Weather, Events, Tourism, VCB, bayris
- ELSTER (electronic tax returns) and pilot electronic wage tax card
- RegisStar (electronic commercial register) available to everybody via the Internet since June 2002
- SolumStar (electronic land register) since January 2002 all Bavarian Land Register Offices




# **Example: Public Authority Guide**


- Contains general, supra-regional factual information (according to life situations)

- Contains government forms (Goal: online-traffic)




#### **Selection Life Situations or Public Services**




#### **The Life Situations**




### **Life Situation Mobility**
