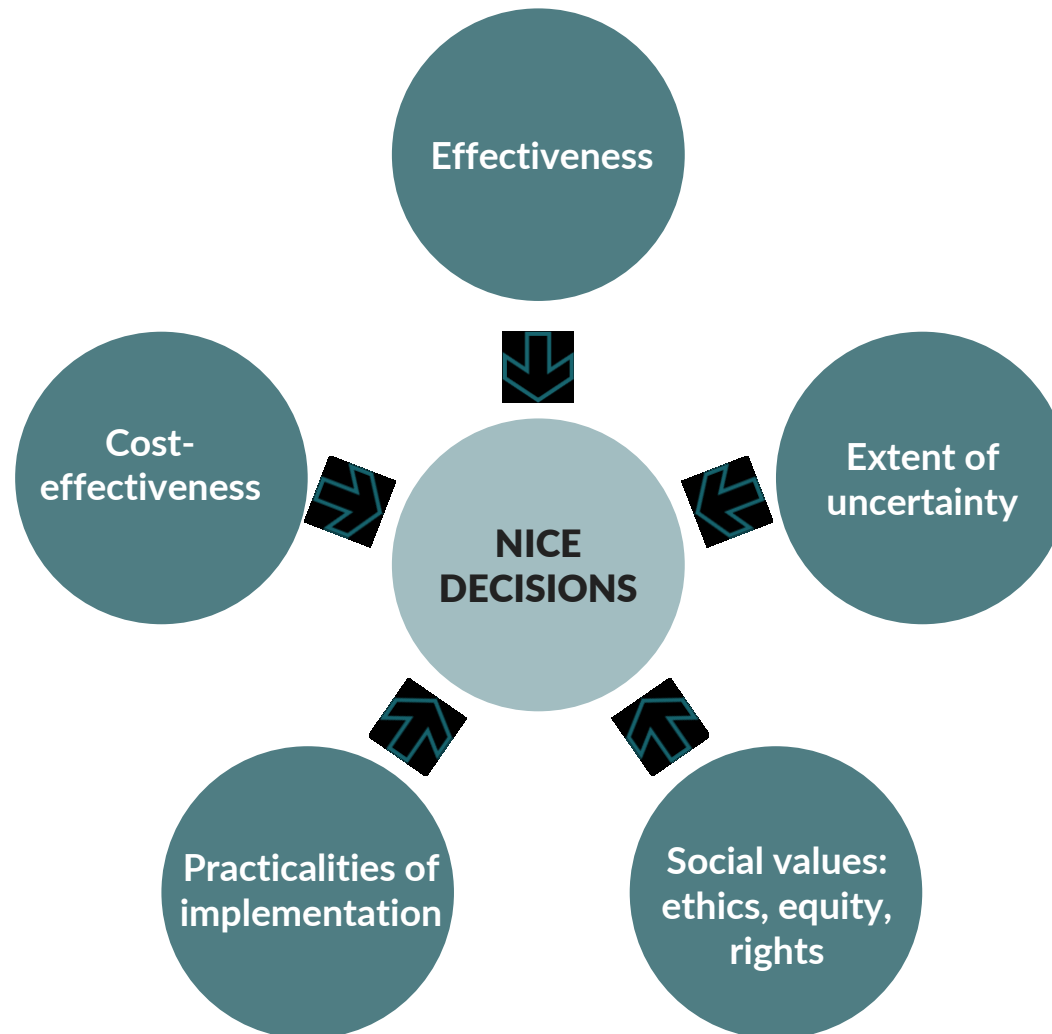


Core principles of NICE's work

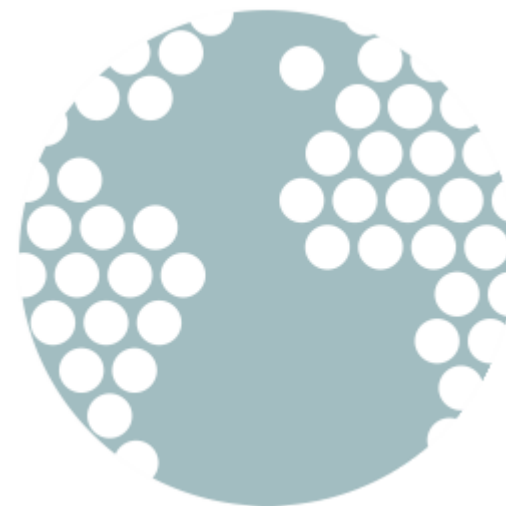
