




Statistical data on the development of IS in the Republic of Macedonia

"Information society measurement" by ITU

- ICT development index is calculated for 159 countries and the ICT price basket index for 161 countries.
- Among the highest ranked countries, as countries with strongest achievements are Bahrain, Greece, United Arab Emirates and the Republic of Macedonia
- The total score of the republic of Macedonia has grown from 3.40 to 4.32 which is a movement of 12 places.
 The Republic of Macedonia has the 51th place from the total 159 countries.
