

HP's Strategy in the Public Sector



Our solutions are Citizen Centric (vs. government centric)

Citizens get a better level of services and get these services faster

We use a Best in Breed approach (vs. we can do it all)

Innovative Financing



HP found a way to make it affordable:

- PPP Public Private Partnerships
 - (e.g. Bulgaria Ministry of Interior for "Secure Documents")
- BOT Build, Operate, Transfer
 - (e.g. Population Registry for Ministry of Interior Israel)
- Services Partnerships
 - (e.g. Poland's Car Registration System)

Third Party Financing (EU, WB, ExIm, ...)

E-Government Traps



- Focus too much on back and integration
 - Citizens need to see the benefits
 - Systems that don't provide a benefit will not be used
- Keep upgrading proprietary solutions
 - Often easier to maintain old problems then to implement new solutions
 - Are costly in maintenance and support
- Buy proprietary solutions
 - Slow and costly in implementation
 - Low incentive to re-design process to be citizen centric

Trends in the Public Sector



Citizens expect a "Return on Election" within 6-8 months

Governments need "quick wins"

There is less and less investment money available

> Governments start to use PPP, BOT and Outsourcing

Citizens see Governments as "Single Services Entity"

> Need for "seamless 24 x 7 citizen centric services"
